Former FAA Administrator Jane Garvey Joins Metron Aviation Board of Directors

Ms. Garvey received the National Air Transportation Association's Distinguished Service Award and the National Council of Public-Private Partnerships Leadership Award, among many others.

During her tenure as FAA Administrator, Ms. Garvey successfully managed the FAA's seamless Y2K transition. Her stewardship fostered industry-wide collaboration as the FAA modernized the national airspace with the deployment of new technology solutions. She is recognized as providing the foundation for NextGen through the adoption of free flight principles.
